Starting and Exiting the Cisco IPeXchange Monitor

System Requirements

The Cisco IPeXchange Monitor can be accessed from any computer, including a PC, Macintosh, or UNIX workstation, that supports an HTML version 2 web browser, such as NetScape 2.0 or higher. This computer can be located anywhere on a network, as long as you can access the Cisco IPeXchange Internet Gateway through an IP connection.

The Cisco IPeXchange Monitor is part of the Cisco IPeXchange Internet Gateway. The recommended configuration is one NetWare server and one Cisco IPeXchange Internet Gateway per IPX network.

Starting the Cisco IPeXchange Monitor and Logging In

Follow these steps to start the monitor and log in:

Step 1 Launch your web browser.

Step 2 Enter the Cisco IPeXchange Internet Gateway URL or IP address in the location field:

http://IJ-gateway-hostname-or-IP-address

The monitor Login window should appear.

Step 3 Enter the monitor supervisor password.

The first time you log in, the password is **ij.super**. You should change this password to a secret password.

Note If the ijcagdb.db file on the gateway is lost and the gateway is restarted, the monitor supervisor password goes back to ij.super.

- Step 3 Type the new password in the New password field.
- Step 4 Type the new password again in the Retype new password field.
- Step 5 Click OK to save the new password, or click Cancel to not change the password.
